## Pearls of Wisdom

Doug Winfrey and Dr. Wallach discuss two news articles concerning a study on medical mistakes in the U.S. health system. The study compared two older methods of tracking medical errors with a newer system. The research team looked at the records of nearly 800 patients at three hospitals and compared the three tracking methods on the same records. The team found the "volutary reporting system" found four errors, the system used by the "Agency for Healthcare Research" detected 35 errors. While the newest system called the "global trigger tool" where a third partied evaluated the records using a quality checklist found 354 errors out of 795 records reviewed.
